

Park House FAQs

Is the accommodation mixed gender?

No, Park House accommodates women only

Can I arrive early?

In most cases it will be possible for you to arrive early but this will depend on the room you are moving in to and when it will be available. It is best to check with the office as soon in advance as possible. If it is not possible to move you in to your room early we may be able to find another room for the short term or allocate you a temporary room in one of our sister hostels. In all cases a charge will be made for the additional days.

Can I bring my car?

Parking is not readily available in the surrounding streets so it is best not to bring your car. The hostel is very close to the tube station and on several major bus routes so getting around shouldn't be a problem.

What do the fees cover?

Your rent covers the cost of your room and all utilities (water, gas and electricity)

How and when do I pay?

Your rent is due in advance and short stays (less than 5 weeks) will usually be asked for payment for the total stay in advance of your arrival. There are several ways to pay your rent and the office staff will be happy to talk these through with you to help you find the one which suits you best.

Does it cover vacation periods?

If you are going away on holiday, you will still have to pay your rent to cover this period.

Are there telephones provided?

Telephones are not provided in the rooms but the hostel does have a payphone you can use.

Is there internet access in the rooms?

No but there is an internet café located in the basement which is open 24 hours a day.

What equipment is in the bedrooms?

What will I have to bring?

You will need to bring all the equipment you require for the kitchen and if you are here for a long time then most residents prefer to bring their own bedding to make the room more personal. With a few items from home, your room can look like your own space in no time!

Is cleaning provided?

Yes, a basic cleaning service is provided once a week however residents are expected to keep their rooms and their units in a reasonable state.
